Women's services will include:

- Expand, centralize, and enhance a comprehensive range of women's inpatient services, including obstetrics, gynecology, and diagnostic imaging
- Transform the existing Obstetrics entrance and waiting area
- Renovate the existing Nursery into a more calming/comforting environment
- Construct eight private patient suites for obstetrics and postsurgical gynecological patients
- Expand and remodel the women's imaging suites to accommodate leading-edge technology and equipment such as digital mammography, stereotactic breast biopsy, ultrasound, and bone density screenings
- Modernize three state-of-the-art labor/deliver/ recovery rooms
- Addition of imaging services waiting area
- Enhance privacy and convenience throughout the facility
- Increase efficiency to allow physicians, nurses, and other caregivers to spend more time with patients
- Infuse the Dolores Kator Switzer Women's Center with an aesthetically appealing, peaceful atmosphere for and about women that promotes healing and wellness

A plan to expand Women's Services at MDH.

To address the needs of the women in the communities we serve, the MDH and the MDH Foundation Boards of Directors, physicians, and executive leadership have approved a plan to accomplish these improvements.

The MDH Foundation received a lead gift of \$1.9 million from Dick Switzer to be named after his late wife, Dolores Kator Switzer. Dick has also named MDH as the primary beneficiary in his will. The Foundation staff at MDH will work diligently to achieve the remaining campaign goal of \$3.6 million for the project through business and individual donations.





In 2014, Richard (Dick) Switzer donated \$1.9 million to build a women's center at McDonough District Hospital in memory of his late wife Dolores Kator Switzer. Dick's devotion and love for Dolores inspired his generous lead gift and naming opportunity for the future Dolores Kator Switzer Women's Center.

Dick and Dolores came from humble backgrounds and lived a modest life together. Both were lifetime Leathernecks, and they loved to travel. Dolores dedicated her time and heart to service. Dolores worked at Western Illinois University for 34 years as Registrar and later as Director of Graduate and Foreign Admissions. Dolores passed away on October 19, 2013.

"I'm adamant that everything be named after Dolores because it was her income we invested. She trusted me, and it paid off," said Dick. "It's important to me that everyone knows what an amazing woman Dolores was. I loved her with all of my heart."

The Dolores Kator Switzer Women's Center will strengthen comprehensive women's health services in the region.
